

Facts for Your Noggin

Though the origins of eggnog may be slightly muddled, one thing's certain: It hits the spot when you want a rich, creamy treat during the holidays.

Some say eggnog is a variation of the milk and wine mixers popular in the Old World. Because wine was heavily taxed in the colonies, rum was substituted instead.

Rum was called "grog," so "eggnog" might have come from the name "egg and grog." Others say "nog" is the term for the wooden mug in which the drink was typically served. Perhaps the truth is a blend of both stories when "egg and grog" was served in a "nog."

While typically indulged in only during the holiday season today, eggnog historically was a general winter beverage.
